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RODENT CONTROL OPTIONS IN CALIFORNIA

Production Agriculture

SECOND-GENERATION ANTICOAGULANTS (SGARs)

AB1788 prohibits many uses of SGARs, but contains an exemption for “agricultural activities” including “agricultural production sites”. Since 2014, The California Department of Pest Regulation (CDPR) has designated all SGARs as RESTRICTED MATERIALS. This designation is unchanged under the new law.

In the State of California:

- ▶ SGAR Products can only be purchased and applied by certified private applicators or those under their direct supervision.
- ▶ All certified applicators must obtain a restricted materials permit from the County Agricultural Commissioner (CAC) before purchasing or using an SGAR product. For more information contact your local CAC.
- ▶ CDPR allows livestock and poultry producers to qualify for a private applicator certificate. SGAR products can be used by private applicators ONLY if they intend to protect structures related to the production of an agricultural commodity.

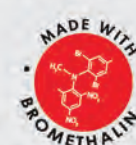

HOW TO GET CERTIFIED IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Most counties require you to pass an exam to obtain your private applicators certification, however specific requirements vary by county. Contact your County Agricultural Commissioner (CAC) for more information.



NON-ANTICOAGULANT RODENTICIDE BAIT



Rampage products contain the acute active ingredient Bromethalin. They are **NOT** subject to the restrictions that impact SGAR products and are **NOT** considered a Restricted Use Pesticide in the state of California.



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California Assembly Bill AB1788 FACT vs. FICTION



On August 31, 2020 the California Legislature passed AB1788, which was signed into law by Governor Newsom on September 29 and will go into effect on January 1, 2021. There have been a lot of rumors and misinformation about this legislation. Below is a summary of some of the facts and fiction to help address some of the confusion about the new law.

FACTS

California AB1788 prohibits many uses of rodenticides that contain CERTAIN active ingredients

AB1788 only impacts Second Generation Anticoagulant Rodenticides (SGARs)

SGARs (baits containing brodifacoum, bromadiolone, difenacoum or difethialone) have been classified as restricted use materials since 2014

AB1788 includes an exemption to use SGARs around agricultural production buildings with the proper restricted materials license

FICTION

AB1788 Bans ALL rodenticides in California

AB1788 affects ALL rodenticides in California

Non-SGAR Baits (Bromethalin, Cholecalciferol, Zinc Phosphide) are banned in California

Farmers can still buy and use any rodenticide they want

California does not have any additional restrictions on Rodenticides containing First Generation Anticoagulants and Acute active ingredients, beyond what's allowed on federal labeling. CDPR follows the federal regulations with regards to these products, which allow them to be sold in Farm Stores and Ag Dealers without any special licensing or permits.
