ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to birds, fish, and other wildlife. Wildlife feeding on treated bait may be killed. Dogs, cats, and other predatory and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten this bait. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present. Do not allow the bait to be exposed on the soil surface.

ENDANGERED SPECIES CONSIDERATIONS: The use of this product may pose a hazard to Federally designated endangered/ threatened species. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product may only be used to control voles (*Microtus* spp.) and deer mice (*Peromyscus* spp.) in hop fields (post-harvest or dormant season use only) and adjacent non-crop areas bordering hop fields.

Before application, locate vole trails, runway systems, and harborage areas to be treated. Select warm, clear days for bait application. Preferably, make the application when the grass has not yet matted. Bait is more readily accepted when voles are protected by vegetation.

Hand Baiting:

Place bait near the base of each infested hop crown at 2 - 4 locations, either on surface trails or at the mouth of holes leading to underground burrow systems. Cover bait artificially (e.g., mats, boards) or by pulling overhanging vegetation over bait. Do not allow bait to be exposed on bare ground. Do not disturb the runway system. Apply at a rate of 1 teaspoon (4 grams) per placement, 2 – 3 lb./A (0.04 – 0.06 lb. ai/A).

Ground or Aerial Broadcast Baiting:

Broadcast evenly using commercial bait dispensing equipment—target baiting areas with the heaviest vegetative cover. Do not broadcast bait on bare ground. Do not apply by air when the wind exceeds 10 mph. Do not apply bait in piles or permit piles to be formed by equipment. Apply at a rate of 6 – 10 lb./A (0.12 – 0.2 lb. ai/A).

Application Restrictions:

- Applicators must wear chemical-resistant gloves when hand baiting.
- Do not apply bait more than twice per year.
- A second application may be required in years with heavy infestations. Do not reapply bait within 30 days of the first application.
- A maximum of 6 lbs. (0.12 lb. active) of bait per acre may be applied annually by hand baiting.
- A maximum of 20 lbs. (0.4 lb. active) of bait per acre may be applied annually by ground or aerial broadcast.
- Only apply bait after fall harvest, before new spring growth, and when no rain or snow is expected for three consecutive days.
- Do not apply bait during the growing season.
- Do not apply bait to crops or sites not specified above.
- Do not apply bait in a manner that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Keep all other persons out of the treated area during application.
- Do not allow pets, livestock, or other non-target animals to be exposed to bait.

WSDA Container Disposal Guidance:

Completely empty container contents into application equipment and apply according to the label directions. The empty container may be disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Burning is not a legal method of container disposal in Washington.
